

How It Works

From May 1 – October 1, a simple click or call reserves your use of a 23 foot boat or larger. Up to two members from one immediate family can be listed on the membership. Up to 8 guests are allowed on the boat due to capacity. Reservations are on a first come, first serve basis with a maximum 2 reservations on file at any one time (1 weekday and 1 weekend or holiday). Member is limited to 35 uses during boat club season. For each additional use Member will be charge \$189.00 plus fuel per use. Reservation times consist of a morning, afternoon or evening slot. At the time of your reservation, check in at the Gage Marine Concierge Desk located on the dock to receive your keys. The boat will be fueled and waiting at our pier.

What's Included

- 1. Boat instruction and safety course.
- 2. Insurance, maintenance, cleaning and storage.
- 3. Equipment rental and a cooler with ice on request (small fee required.)

Membership Requirements

- 1. Must be 25 year of age or older.
- 2. Valid driver's license and good driving record (driving record may be reviewed by insurance company).
- 3. Proof of auto insurance.
- 4. Proof of proficiency on boat club vessels.
- 5. Boater Education Card required for anyone born beginning in 1989. All other members must obtain card after one year.

Usage Guidelines

- 1. Compliance with Membership Agreement.
- 2. Must follow all state, local, and federal boating laws.
- 3. Must place credit card on file. That credit card will be charged accordingly for fuel consumed. 50% deposit to be paid at signing. The remainder must be paid in full, 30 days later.
- 4. Financially responsible for damaging or losing club property and equipment (including boats).
- 5. Ensure that boats are properly secured when docked or anchored.
- 6. Must follow check-in and check-out procedures.
- 7. Only the 2 Boat Club members may operate boats. One of the two must be present at all times.
- 8. Operators must never use or be under the influence of alcohol or drugs while operating boats.
- 9. Operators are responsible for their passengers and guests following boat club rules.
- 10. Member is responsible for removing all personal items and refuse when returning boats.
- 11. Member is responsible to ensure all electrical and mechanical devices, such as depth finders, GPS, radios, motors etc. are off and secured when returning boats.
- 12. Members are responsible for providing fitted PFDs for children 12 and under. Boat club provides the required number of PFDs per boat.
- 13. No pets allowed on boats at any time.
- 14. No trailering or removing vessels from water is allowed.
- 15. No fishing allowed on Boat Club boats at any time.
